## **Dress Code**

Your school uniform confirms your attendance at Holy Rosary School and is a symbol of unity within the school community. It minimizes distractions in the learning process. It is important that you take pride in your appearance by wearing your complete uniform always remembering that by wearing it inside and outside the classroom and the school you are representing the school and your behavior should be a credit to both yourself and the school community. Uniforms must be purchased from Flynn O'Hara Uniform Company.

From November 1<sup>st</sup> through April 15<sup>th</sup> the HRS uniform is as follows:

Pre-K: optional HRS sweat suit and white sneakers

### **Girls grades K-4**

- \*light blue, round collar blouse
- \*school tie
- \*plaid jumper from the uniform co.

- \*navy knee high socks/tights
- \*school sweater from the uniform co.
- \*during the winter, girls may wear the uniform slacks from the uniform co.

### **Girls grades 5-8**

- \*light blue, pointed collar blouse with v-neck
- \*no tie
- \*plaid skirt worn to the knee/solid blue vest from the uniform co.

- \*navy knee high socks/tights/stockings
- \*school sweater from the uniform co.

### **Boys grades K-8**

- \*light blue dress shirt from the uniform company
- \*navy dress slacks from the uniform company
- \*plaid uniform tie
- \*navy or black socks and belt

During the cold weather, students may wear the navy blue uniform cardigan sweater or the uniform school sweatshirt with HRS emblem. Other types of sweaters or sweatshirts may not be worn during the school day

From April 15<sup>th</sup> through October 31<sup>st</sup>, student may wear the following OPTIONAL summer uniform:

**\*Girls K-4:** light blue summer dress from the uniform co., white knee socks; or navy Bermuda shorts with HRS polo shirt-both from uniform co.

**\*Girls 5-8:** light blue summer skirt to the knee, white short sleeve blouse/white school polo shirt-all from the uniform co., white knee socks; or navy Bermuda shorts with HRS polo shirt-both from uniform co.

**\*Boys K-8:** white school polo shirt with navy dress slacks or navy Bermuda length shorts- from the uniform co.

**Shoes: \*GIRLS: black or blue lace up oxford dress shoe or buckle shoe must be worn;**

**\*BOYS: black oxford lace up**

**\*The following are not permitted: gum soled; waffle bottom; boots; patent leather; ankle boots; hush puppy/suede; heels;**

**Jewelry: students may ONLY wear the following**

**\*Girls:** post earrings (no larger than dime sized with no hanging earring); only one pair permitted and it must be worn on the lobe; one watch; one religious medal worn underneath the top (no other jewelry may be worn)

**\*Boys:** no earring may be worn by boys; only one watch and a religious medal (beneath the shirt) may be worn (no other jewelry may be worn)

Make-up: no form of any make up is permitted

Nails: (the following is permitted only for girls) clear nail polish only; no fake nails, wraps etc...

Hair accessories for girls only: (the following is permitted only for girls) a single head band, one inch or smaller in width, in solid blue or white may be worn; one single set of barrettes in solid blue or white may be worn; no other items may be worn in the hair

**Hair: should be clean and well groomed. No FAD hairstyles, or hair styles, such as but not limited to, are permitted: braids/tails etc.. in boys; neither boys nor girls may have dyed hair/highlights/colors/extensions/lock/spikes/shaved designs/mohawks,etc..; hair in boys must not fall below the shirt collar or be higher than one inch**
