

Holy Rosary School Summer Enrichment Program

Thank you for enrolling your child in the Holy Rosary School Enrichment Program! Enclosed, you will find an outline of the program, rules and regulations, outline of trips and other activities, supplies that are needed, and a dress code for the summer. I. Outline of the Enrichment Program The Enrichment Program is a place for Holy Rosary Students, as well as students from other Catholic schools, to spend their days enjoying summer activities, academic review, and religious studies. There are also a variety of field trips and opportunity for arts and crafts.

Academic Review - There will be approximately one hour of academic review per day. This may be done in a variety of ways, depending on the teacher. Academic review will consist of subject areas taught during the school year. There are no tests, and no homework.

Religious Studies – Each day will also include approximately one hour of religious study.

Trips - There will be one to two trips per week depending on the weather.

Supplies - A minimum amount of supplies are needed for the Enrichment Program. (Please see page 3 for list of supplies.)

Dress code – Program T-shirt, sneakers and shorts.

Extreme Weather – In the event of extreme weather conditions the camp will be moved to Father Winters Hall, which is located in the lower level of Holy Rosary Church located off of Eastchester and Gunhill Road.

II. Rules and Regulations

While the Enrichment Program is more relaxed than the regular school day, there are few rules and regulations to follow:

- The hours of the Enrichment Program are 8a.m. to 5p.m. All students should be to enter the school via the school year to the cafeteria. Arrangements will have to be made for early drop off or late pick up. Additional fees may apply.
- Please call the school if your child is going to be absent or late. The number to call is 718 652 1838.
- Children are expected to be on their best behavior at all times.

- Children must obey their camp counselor and the teacher in charge.
- Fighting or the use of offensive language, or other offensive behavior, is strictly prohibited.
- Lunch is provided, but your child may also bring lunch.
- Cell phones or other electronic devices are allowed to be used during the day **BUT ONLY DURING DESIGNATED TIME.**
- Parents may volunteer to assist on trip days, please let us know if you would be interest in volunteering.

III. Financial Responsibility

- Program fees are due the first day of the week in **cash or money orders only as the program does not accept personal checks.** If your child is enrolled for the whole program, you may pay in full in advance. Trip fees are due on the second day of the week in cash only.

IV. Trips

- Walking trips - There will be walking trips that are usually within one mile. Some walking trips may include local parks and libraries.
- Bus trips - School buses will be used for trips that are longer than one mile.
- A trip schedule will be given in the beginning of the week that will include the weekly trip fee.
- Public transportation may be used when possible.

V. Other Activities

- Computer lab

VI. Supplies

- Small book bag
- One piece bathing suit for girls with a cover-up.
- Swim trunks for boys
- Swim shoes **A MUST AS WE USE THE YARD AS A WATER PARK**
- Towel
- Swim cap if necessary
- Sun block
- Change of clothes
- No beach chairs, umbrella, etc.

VII. Dress code

- For all trips, the Enrichment Program T-Shirt should be worn
- No revealing clothing
- Sneakers with socks, extra socks are a good idea
- Sandals and sport sandals are permitted but **no flip-flops, WE DO A LOT OF RUNNING AROUND AND FLIP-FLOPS ARE NOT A GOOD IDEA**
- No jewelry
